During July optical fibres for Internet for two neighbours was put down crossing our garden. As it passed only 2 meters from our house, we joined the fibre net.



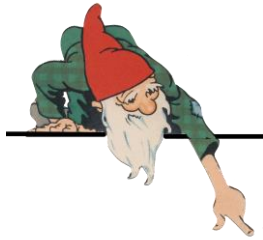
